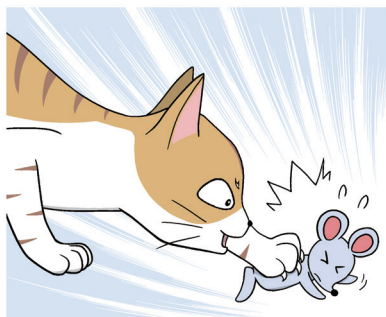


# Andy and Jimmy

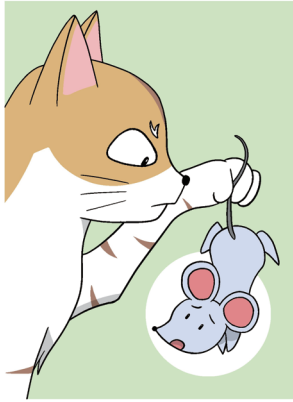

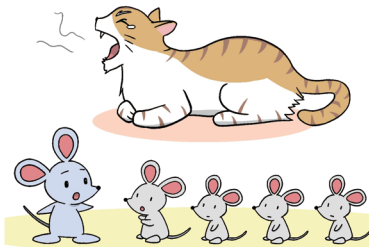
